Instructor examinations (I.E) are run 4 times a year on the Gold Coast, the cost of participating in this is around \$700 and is payable directly to PADI at the start of the examination.

Payment plans are available, they can be tailored to suit our particular situation and needs. Incentives offered for upfront payment.

A non-refundable deposit of \$400 is required for the IDC, this covers the elearning access code cost.

Prerequisites:

All courses require a current recreational dive medical, recreational level and professional level.

Rescue diver: a current EFR certificate

Dive Master: You need to have a current EFR certificate, at least Rescue diver certification and you need to have logged at least 40 dives and be at least 18 years of age.

Instructor Development course: Dive Master rating, current EFR cert, at least 18 years of age and logged at least 100 dives.

Rescue and Dive Master courses are run on demand and we specialise in fitting in with your availability.

Instructor Development Courses (IDC) are run four times a year to coincide with PADI Instructor Examinations. They generally start 8 days prior to an IE.
